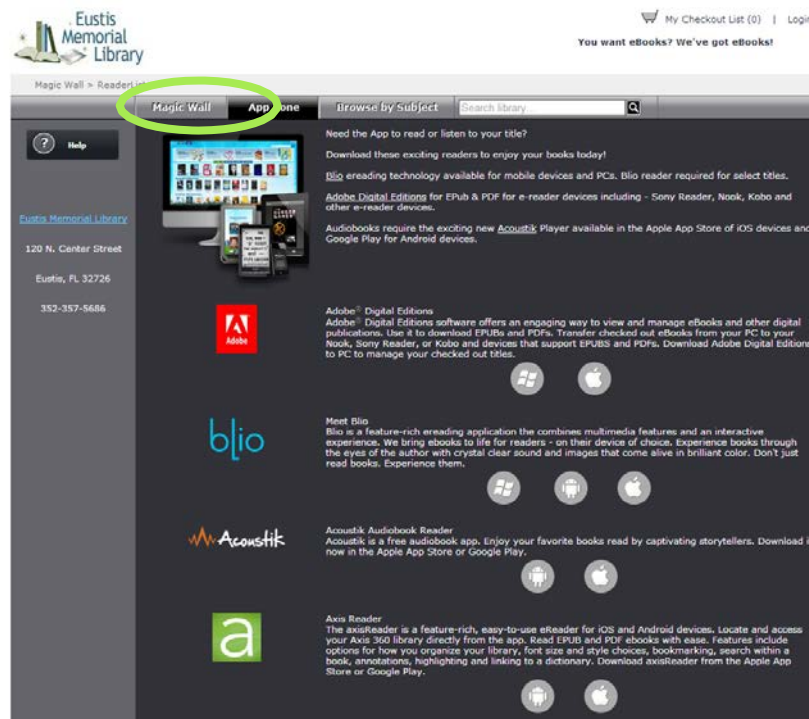

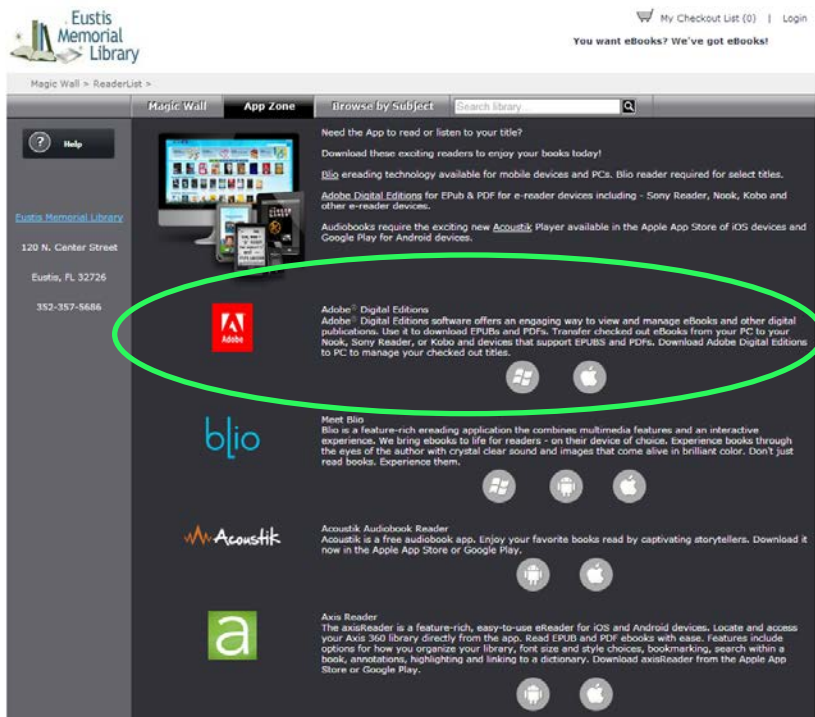
Checking out an eBook is a two part process: 1) Check out an eBook using the Magic Wall and 2) download the book to your device using Adobe Digital Editions.

# Checking Out an eBook Using the Magic Wall

1. Before you download an ePub/PDF format title from Axis 360 you must have Adobe Digital Editions downloaded to your computer. If you have not loaded Adobe Digital Editions, please go to the Magic Wall: <http://eml.axis360.baker-taylor.com/>
2. Next, click on the "Apps Zone" tab.



3. Download Adobe Digital Editions to your computer. Make sure you select the appropriate icon for your operating system.

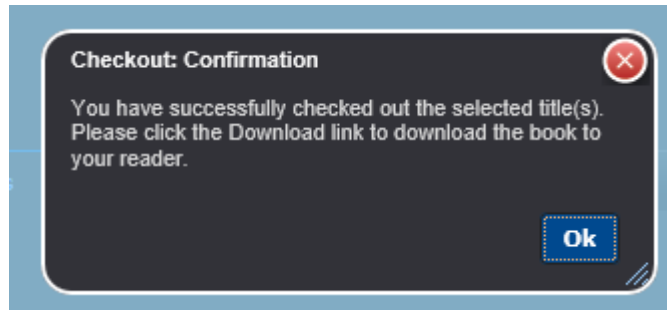


- After you download Adobe Digital Editions to your computer, you can go back to the Magic Wall to check out a book. Once you have selected the book that you want to check out make sure the select the ePub format and then click on "Checkout Now."



- Next, you will need to enter your library card number and PIN. If you don't remember you PIN, please call the front desk at (352)357-5686.

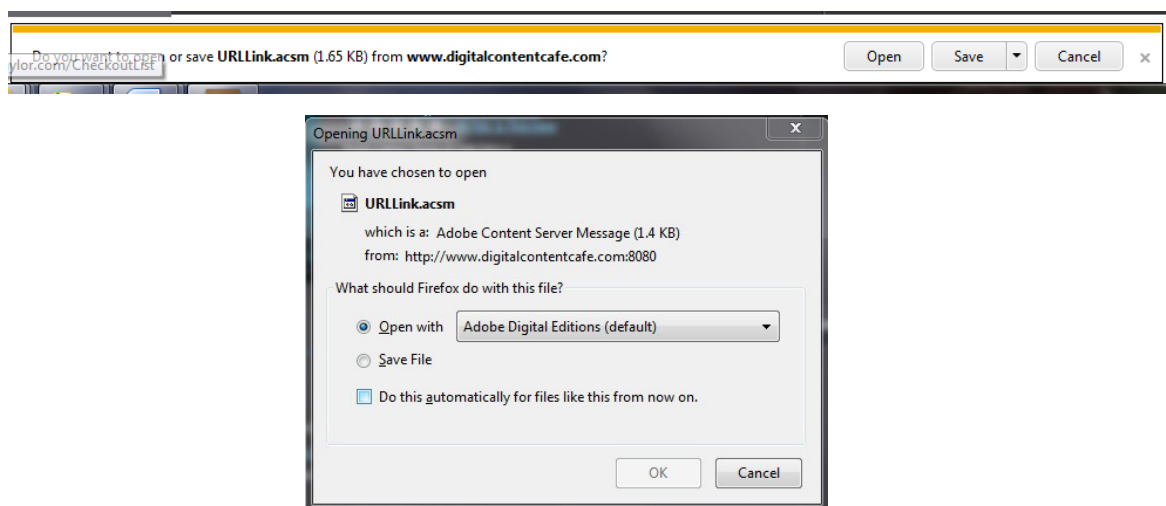
- You will get a message that confirms checkout. Click OK.



- You will see a download link. Clicking on this link will download the book to your Adobe Digital Editions.

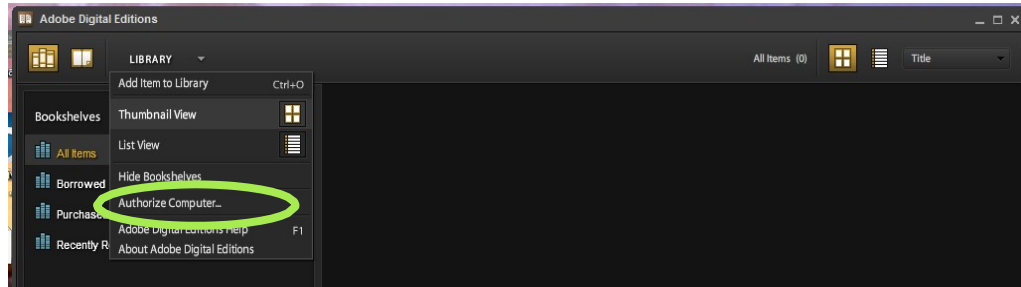


- You will get a pop up window asking you if you want to download the book. The window will look like one of the two options below:

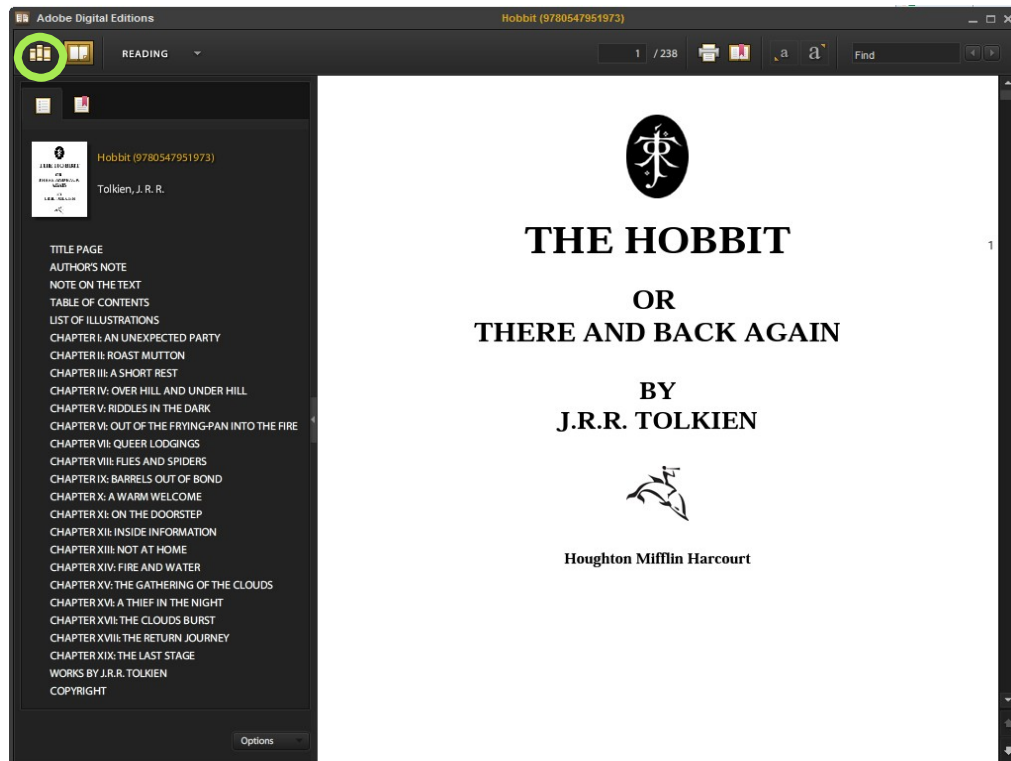


Make sure to select "Open" or "Open with" and then "ok."

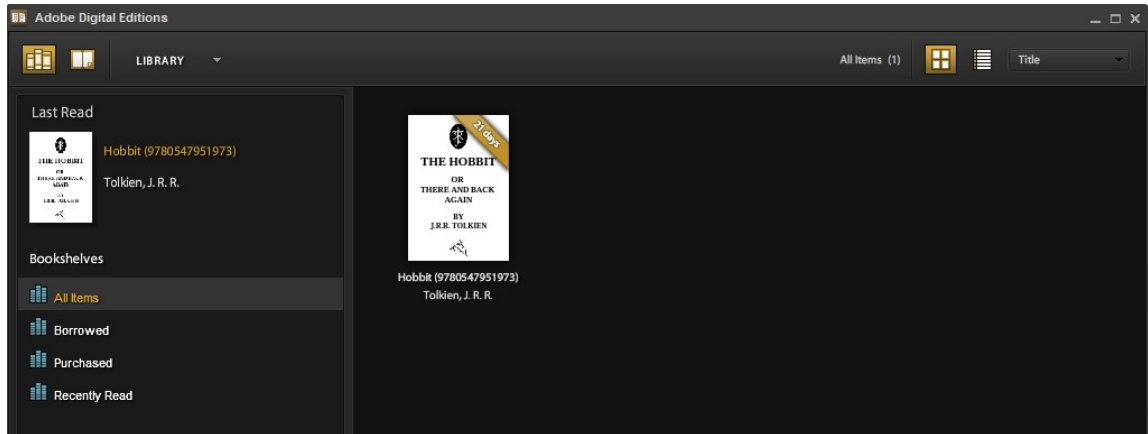
9. If this is your first time using Adobe Digital Editions you will need to create an Adobe ID and password.
10. You will also need to authorize your computer in order to transfer books from the Adobe Digital Editions library to your device. Click on "Library" to get a drop down menu. Then select "Authorize Computer."



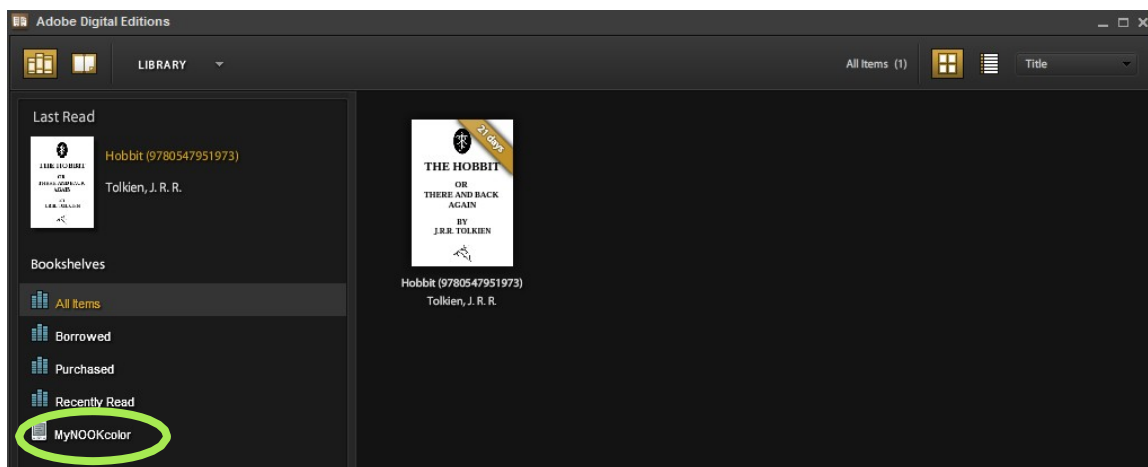
11. After you have completed these steps the book will download to your library. It will automatically open. Click on the books icon to go back to the library.



12. Your screen should now look like this:



13. Next, turn on your device and connect it to your computer using the USB cable. The device should appear in Adobe Digital Editions. If this is your first time connecting the device while in Adobe Digital Editions you may be asked to authorize the device.



14. Drag the book and drop it over your device on the screen. In this example, the device is MyNookColor. The book will transfer to the Nook. Please note that if the computer and device are not authorized the book will not transfer and you will get an error message.

15. To read the book on your Nook, go to the library icon. Then, select "My Files." After that select "Digital Editions." Finally, find the book you checked out and open it.
